keep you updated on progress.





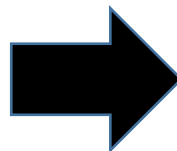
HANGI – This Friday

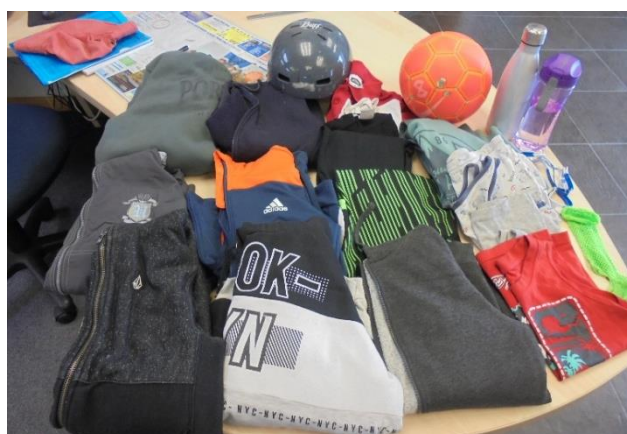
